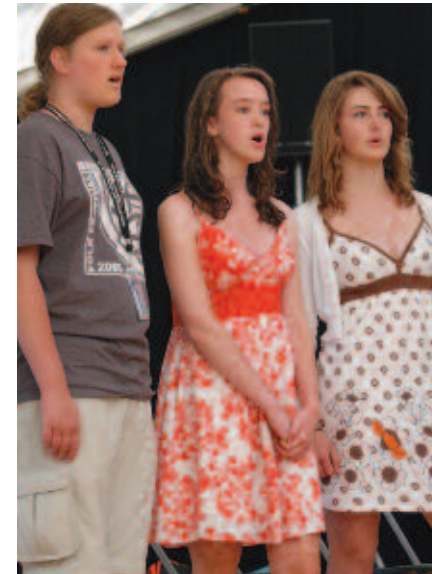

And you will be able to join the Easter School evening programme of concerts, talks, ceilidhs, folk clubs and instrumental sessions.

The cost of the course is £120 – this includes full board, accommodation and tuition fees. This is heavily subsidised by a grant from Arts Council England. However, Folk South West is able to offer a limited number of bursaries from the Bill Rutter Memorial Fund which would bring the cost down to £100.

Chantmarle is in West Dorset, roughly half way between Yeovil and Dorchester.
